WHAT IS POSTPIL®

- Emergency contraceptive to use after unprotected intercourse or in case of known or suspected contraceptive failure
- Package contains 1 tablet of levonorgestrel 1.5 mg
- Conforms to Eur. Pharmacopeia and manufactured at an EU cGMP-approved facility
- Not an abortion pill; does not terminate established pregnancy
- Does not protect against sexually transmitted infections (STIs)

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WHEN TO USE POSTPIL®

- Can be used at any time during the menstrual cycle for the following situations:
 - Desire to avoid pregnancy
 - Nonconsensual or forced unprotected sex
 - Possible contraceptive failure or incorrect use
 - o Concern about the withdrawal method
 - Uncertainty about the 'safe period'
- Can be used if already administered in the same menstrual cycle

HOW POSTPIL® WORKS

- Disrupts ovulation and thickens the cervical mucus, which inhibits sperm mobility and prevents fertilization
- No examinations or laboratory tests needed¹
- Reduces risk of pregnancy by 80%-90%
- **Side effects may include**: nausea, lower abdominal pain, fatigue, headache, dizziness, breast tenderness, delay of menses (>7 days)

HOW TO USE POSTPIL®

- To be used as soon as possible up to 3 days (72 hours) after unprotected intercourse for best results. Postpil® is more effective the sooner it is taken after unprotected sex.
- Dosage should not be taken more than once within 24 hours, except if the woman vomits within 2 hours after use
- Risk of pregnancy if repeated unprotected intercourse within 24 hours after taking the Postpil®
